

In October the E6 north of Malmö will be closed for two weeks

Traffic will be diverted - expect major disruptions

The Swedish Transport Administration (Trafikverket) needs to rebuild the E6 motorway bridge at the Alnarp junction north of Malmö to accommodate the railway expansion between Lund and Arlöv.

For approximately 2 weeks following 11 October 2018, the E6 will be closed in both directions at the Alnarp junction. Maintenance works will also take place on the E6 in the weeks leading up to the closure and might also affect traffic.

Diversion routes during the closure

Traffic will be diverted to other routes during the motorway closure. Alternatives will be signposted. Expect major traffic disruptions and congestion on the E6 and other roads in south-west Skåne.

LUND-ARLÖV, FOUR TRACKS

Reconstruction work of the railway tracks between Malmö and Lund began in autumn 2017. The two existing tracks will become four, increasing capacity on the route and reducing disruptions to train traffic.

The E6 motorway bridge will be rebuilt in two stages. The first stage in autumn 2018 and the second between 2020-2022. Again, the E6 will be closed for approximately 2 weeks.
